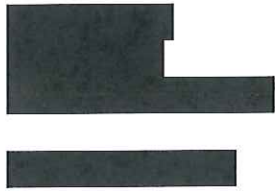

Your conduct at Atlanta Motor Speedway, on July 2nd, 2015 was in violation of the "Participant Conduct" code on page 13 of the 2015 INEX Official Rulebook. Your actions in the pit area were reckless, dangerous, disruptive, and out of order.

This rule states "INEX members, associate members and participants at INEX sanctioned events are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and non-disruptive manner. Any member, associate member, or participant who within the boundaries of the race track facility, in the sole and absolute judgment of INEX;

- Physically assaults another participant, official or other person,
- engages in unsportsmanlike conduct, or conduct detrimental to the sport of Thunder Roadster, Legends Cars or Bandolero Cars racing or,
- otherwise creates a condition or circumstances which is unsafe, unfair or out of order, shall have violated the rules of INEX and will be penalized by the INEX Director accordingly.

Drivers (or their designated parent or guardian if the driver is under 18 years of age) are responsible for the conduct of their crew or anyone else associated with their team. A driver may suffer the penalties for the conduct of their crew or associates.

For those who violate these rules and regulations INEX may take action ranging from probation to expulsion. Physical violence may be prosecuted through local, state, or federal enforcement authorities."

After reviewing the circumstances surrounding the situation, INEX has decided to issue you a suspension from all INEX sanctioned events for the next three weeks, ending July 24th, 2015. INEX has also decided to fine you \$300.00 dollars to be paid before you attend your next INEX sanctioned event. Additionally, INEX is putting you on probation for six months, ending on January 2nd, 2015. You will not be admitted into the pit area of any INEX sanctioned event until your fine is paid in full.

The INEX "Participant Conduct" code is at the forefront of all Legends racing; please help us maintain that standard by complying with all INEX rules and regulations and conducting yourself in a respectful manner.

Any action taken during your probation that INEX deems inappropriate will result in additional penalties.
