If this type of behavior continues we will be forced to take further action resulting in the possibility of a fine, suspensions of varying lengths, or loss of points.

This letter is considered an official warning and should be regarded with heightened concern. We will be in contact with track officials for upcoming races to verify that this situation has been rectified.

Once again, INEX Competitor conduct is at the forefront of all Legends racing; please help us maintain that standard by complying with all INEX rules and regulations and competing in a respectful manner.
